

Constitution of the Chiang Mai Lanna Cricket Club (formed 2012)

1. Objectives and Spirit

Chiang Mai Lanna Cricket Club (CMLCC) will treat as priority the provision for people to play and enjoy cricket in an atmosphere conducive to the ideals of sport. Men and women, boys and girls will be welcomed into CMLCC with no proviso, except that there be no selfish motives in their participation and that good conduct and friendship amongst members should prevail.

2. Committee and Meetings

A committee to carry out the running of CMLCC must include a Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and at least three other members. General meetings should be arranged so that at least five committee members can attend. All members should be invited with notice given a minimum of 14 days in advance (28 days for the AGM). Meetings should be held at a suitable venue. The Chairman should form an agenda with minutes taken by the Secretary and subsequently made available to all members.

3. Club Fees

CMLCC will require members to pay an annual membership fee and a match fee. The amount of the fees will be decided by the Committee and revised annually if necessary.

4. Matches and Facilities

Other issues such as the formation of a League, match rules, umpiring, scoring, and use of grounds and facilities will be decided in conjunction with other bodies, clubs, organisations and the Chiangmai Gymkhana Club.

5. Amendments to the Constitution

Amendments the CMLCC Constitution can only be made at AGMs and only under exceptional circumstances.
